Vols., having enlisted on or about the 6<sup>th</sup> day of April 1865

as a Private and having been discharged as a Private

on or about the 13<sup>th</sup> day of July 1865 at Greenborough, D.C.

by reason of loss of board who died August 1<sup>st</sup> 1883

from disability incurred in the service

and who never served in the army, navy or marine corps of the United States other

than as above stated, except from the day of 186

to the day of 186 in Company of the

Regiment Vols.

This claim is made for widow's pension from the  
date of the soldier's death, August 1, 1883  
to the date of her remarriage, June 2,  
1887.

Children of the soldier under sixteen  
at the date of his death are Mildred  
C. Allen born Nov. 6, 1873, Stella born  
Oct. 30, 1877 and Agnes L. Allen now  
Mrs. J. O. Kernan, born Feb. 20, 1870.
